

The Successful Divorce

The State of Wisconsin, like other states, requires that an Educational Class be completed by all parents of minor children who are involved in a Divorce or Paternity proceedings. Many County Circuit Courts require successful completion of an Educational Class to satisfy Sec. 767.401 of Wisconsin State Statutes.

The Successful Divorce is a 3 hour class to assist divorcing parents of minor children. The class is usually scheduled on the second Saturday of the month from 9:00AM to 12:00PM and third Wednesday of the month from 5:30-8:30PM at 10425 W. North Ave, suite 350 in Wauwatosa

The Successful Divorce Program was first developed in 2000 and has been serving the Educational and Legal needs of divorcing parents in the various Counties in Metropolitan Milwaukee and Green Bay It has an established Track Record. Despite Being mandated to attend the Class and paying a fee, more than 95% of attendees say that it was helpful and would recommend it to others.

Elements of a Successful Divorce

- Divorce ends a Marriage not a Family
- Children continue to have two Parents
- Enhanced Awareness and Skills are required to conduct the Business of Parenting
- In most instances, Children are assured to have Access to both Parents
- Children experience that both Parents Love them and Attend to their Needs
- The Family Lives on and Continues in a new Form
- The Failure of the Marriage becomes less important than the Success of Divorce

- Enhance an understanding of the Impact of Divorce on Children
- Enhance Self-Awareness and Other-Awareness Skills

- Enhance Communication and Conflict Management Skills
- Enhance an understanding of the importance of creation of a Mission and Vision in an outcome driven approach to achieving a Successful Divorce
